An applicable review or application fee may be assessed for any evaluation performed.

2. An applicant shall submit the permit processing fee for a permit which has been processed and denied or withdrawn.
3. All pollution sources shall be subject to an annual emission inspection fee as follows. No more than one fee category may apply to a single source:

4. All fees listed under Sections 612.260, 612.261, and 612.262 shall be adjusted automatically each year by the percentage, if any, by which the CPI for the most recent calendar year ending before the beginning of such calendar differs from the CPI for the calendar year 2019. The CPI for any calendar year is the average of the CPI for all-urban consumers published by the U.S. Department of Labor, as of the close of the twelve-month period ending on August 31 of each calendar year.
5. The Department shall make available, prior to the beginning of each Fiscal Year, a current schedule of fees applicable for that Fiscal Year.
